JIM MOHR MEMORIAL TOURNAMENT RULES
SPECIFIC DIVISION RULES: E-MINOR and MAJOR (13-15 Yr Olds)

OHIO HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION BASEBALL RULES WILL BE USED WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS:

1. All games will be seven (7) innings unless shortened by darkness, weather, field conditions or time limit. If shortened by darkness, weather, field conditions, or time limits and less than five (5) innings have been completed; the game will be resumed from the point of suspension. However, if 5 innings are complete or 4 1/2 if the home team is leading, the game is complete.
2. If a team is leading by 10 or more runs after 5 innings or 4 1/2 if the home team is leading, the umpire will stop the game at the completion of the inning and the leading team will be the winner.
3. No player shall pitch more than seven (7) innings per day.
4. If a team fails to field 9 eligible uniformed players by game time, the umpire and chief will declare a game forfeited in favor of the opposing team. There will be no grace period.
5. Steel cleats will be allowed.
6. Any player who becomes sick or injured during the game may be replaced in the line-up by a previously used sub if no other substitute players exist in accordance with the high school Re-entry Rule. HOWEVER:
 - A) The replacement player will be chosen by the opposing coach.
 - B) Player replaced under this rule is ineligible to play again on the same day.
 - C) The name of the replaced player must be reported to a tournament official.
 - D) Penalty; the use of a player replaced under this rule will result in the forfeiture of the game, in which he plays.
7. **Bat Restrictions:**

A) E-Minor (13 yr Olds)	– 5 (drop five)
B) E-Major (14 & 15 Yr Olds)	– 3 (drop three).
8. No player shall pitch more than **seven (7) innings per day**. A single pitch in an inning is considered an inning pitched.
9. **Time limit of 2 hours and 15 minutes.** No new inning will begin after this limit has expired.
